ELIGIBILITY All female and male contestants who are current members of United States Judo Inc., United States Judo Federation or United States Judo Association. All contestants must be familiar with the sport of Judo and the rules in connection therewith and have sufficient ability to safely compete in this tournament. Contestants, their parents (in the case of minor contestants) and their instructors have the responsibility of ensuring that all contestants meet this requirement.

USJI/USJF/USJA MEMBERSHIP PROOF Current USJI, USJF or USJA membership is required.

ENTRY FEES The non-refundable entry fee of \$30 (*\$25 per contestant if more than one family member is competing*) must accompany the official entry form with the required documents. Personal checks, cashier's checks and money orders are acceptable. A \$10 fee will be charged for all returned checks.

Make all checks payable to "Bay Isle Judo Jujitsu."

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS **Check-in, Registration & Official Weigh-in:** Upon arrival at the tournament site, contestants will register and weigh in for the tournament from 7:45am to 11:00am (as designated above). Competitors must present **current USJF, USJI or USJA** membership card. Those without a valid registration will be required to purchase one in order to participate in the tournament.

WEIGH-IN A contestant is given only one chance on the scale during the official weigh-in. All contestants must compete at their true age and weight except where the participant is uncontested; the tournament director reserves the right to adjust player pools in the best interest and safety of the contestants.

RULES

Current IJF rules will be used with the following modifications:

- Pre-1994 contest rules will be used for the safety zone and out of bounds area.
- Injury Rule: Pre-2003 IJF injury rules

No <i>SHIME WAZA</i> (chokes)	Jr. Division (under 13 yrs)
No double drop-knee <i>SEOI NAGE</i>	Jr. Division
No <i>KANESETSU WAZA</i> (joint lock techniques)	below Shodan
No <i>KANI BASAMI</i> (flying scissors)	all divisions
No <i>KAWAZU GAKE</i> (leg entwining)	all divisions

Bowing is required only at the center of the mat.

Match durations:

Junior Division	2 minutes
Intermediate Division	3 minutes
Black belt Division	5 minutes
Masters Division	4 minutes

Any changes to the pool must be made prior to the start of the pool in order to receive a refund for the tournament.

Winners are determined by: Most Wins, then Most Points, then Head to Head Contest, then Higher Rank Loses, then Smaller Player Wins.

SPECIAL NOTES

Refreshments/concessions will be available for purchase at the tournament venue.

Misconduct or misbehavior at the tournament site may be grounds for expulsion from the tournament competition. Damages are the responsibility of the sensei and/or student.

Contestants must bow at the line in the competition area before and after each contest.

*There will be only one coach per contestant during each match.
A chair will be provided.*

MISCELLANEOUS

Please wear slippers/zori when walking off the mat area.
Please, no food or drinks in the gymnasium. Drinking water is permitted.

DIRECTIONS

From South of Oakland: Go North on I-880 to High Street Oakland Exit. Follow frontage road and turn Left onto High Street. Proceed across bridge for several blocks, turning Right onto Central Avenue. Continue West past Park Street 1 block. Turn Left onto Oak Street and park immediately on the street or in the main gymnasium parking lot ahead on your right.

From North of Oakland: Go South on I-880 to 23rd Avenue Alameda Exit. Follow frontage road for 4 blocks, winding left then right crossing Park Street Bridge. Continue several blocks to Central Avenue and turn Right. At the next block, Oak Street, turn Left. Park immediately on the street or in the main gymnasium parking lot ahead on your right.
